

2010 ELECTION INFORMATION

Election dates for 2010 are:

- Primary Election – Tuesday, August 3, 2010
- General Election – Tuesday, November 2, 2010

These elections are being held statewide and will include federal, state and county offices as well as judicial offices. Those wishing to become a candidate for office in 2010 should contact the Oakland County Election Division at 248-858-0563 for more information.

Offices to be elected this year include:

- Governor
- Representative in Congress (9th District)
- State Senate (12th District)
- Representative to State Legislature (45th District)
- County Commissioner (11th, 12th, and 13th Districts)

Precinct Delegates (Delegates to the County Convention) will also appear on the August Primary Election. Candidate listings are updated on the Oakland County web site (www.oakgov.com) as filings occur. The filing deadline is May 11, 2010, at 4:00 p.m. for all partisan and non-partisan candidates (other than judicial).

At this time there are no official ballot proposals filed for State, County or City of Rochester Hills. If County or Local proposals are to be on a ballot, the ballot language must be certified to the County Clerk by:

- May 25, 2010 for the August Primary Election
- August 24, 2010 for the November General Election

Anyone wishing to circulate petitions for a County or Local ballot proposal must have petitions filed by:

- May 11, 2010 – August Primary Election
- August 10, 2010 – November General Election
