Accolade™ Hybrid Elm (*Ulmus japonica x wilsoniana*)

Origin: Morton Arboretum (IL), parent trees native to Asia

Mature Size: Large (>45' tall)

Description: Accolade™ elm was selected for its vase-shaped mature form, fast growth rate, environmental tolerance, and yellow fall color. It is known to be resistant to Dutch Elm Disease and elm leaf beetle, although it is susceptible to elm leaf miner. Its leaves are larger than Siberian elm, but smaller than American elm. The parent tree measures 60' high by 40' wide.
