### **Crimean Linden (*Tilia x euchlora*)**

Origin: Vegetatively propagated, hybrid of 2 European species

Mature Size: Large (>45')

Description: Crimean linden has a moderate rate of growth and an upright or pyramidal form in youth, becoming rounded with age. It prefers well-drained soil, but is tolerant to a wide range of environmental conditions. It has no serious disease or pest problems, but gypsy moth caterpillars and Japanese beetles will sometimes feed on the leaves. Crimean linden has glossier leaves than most other lindens, and yellow fall color.
