'Fort McNair' Red Horsechestnut (*Aesculus x carnea*)

Origin: Vegetatively propagated; hybrid of Red Buckeye and European Horsechestnut

Mature Size: Medium (35' tall)

Description: 'Fort McNair' Horsechestnut is a relatively slow growing spring flowering tree (May) with rounded form. It prefers well-drained soil with adequate moisture. It will produce seeds (smooth dark brown nuts contained in a rounded husk). 'Fort McNair' was selected from a tree in Washington D.C. for its flower color and resistance to leaf diseases.
