### **Kentucky Coffeetree (*Gymnocladus dioicus*)**

Origin: Seed-grown (normally), native to Michigan

Mature Size: Large (>45' tall)

Description: Kentucky Coffeetree has a slow to moderate rate of growth, and large compound leaves. It prefers relatively alkaline soils, but is tolerant to a wide range of environmental conditions. It does not have any serious disease or pest problems. Fall color is usually yellow. Female trees produce large pods. Male varieties (podless) are now being produced and should be available in the future.
