'Kwanzan' Flowering Cherry (*Prunus serrulata*)

Origin: Very old cultivar, species native to East Asia

Mature Size: Small to Medium (25-35' tall)

Description: 'Kwanzan' Cherry has a slow to moderate growth rate, with vase-shaped form in youth becoming broader with age. Due to its mature width it is not suitable for planting in narrow tree lawns. It has double pink flowers in spring and the new leaves are reddish-green. It has no serious disease or pest problems, but will sometimes be attacked by borers. It normally does not produce fruit. Fall color varies from green to bronze or dark red.
