



## *Prunus* 'Okame'

### **'Okame' Flowering Cherry (*Prunus campanulata x incisa*)**

Origin: Hybridized in the UK, parent species native to China & Japan

Mature Size: Small to Medium (25-35' tall)

Description: 'Okame' Cherry has a slow to moderate growth rate, and upright/oval form in youth becoming rounded with age. It has pink flowers in spring and attractive reddish-brown bark. It has no serious disease or pest problems (certain insects will occasionally feed on the leaves). 'Okame' Cherry may produce some fruit, but it is usually sparse. Fall color varies from green/bronze to dark red.
