### **Silver Linden (*Tilia tomentosa*)**

Origin: native to Eastern Europe and Western Asia

Mature Size: Large (>45' tall)

Description: Silver Linden has a moderate rate of growth, with a somewhat upright form as a young tree, becoming rounded with age. It has dense branching and casts relatively heavy shade. Leaves are dark green on the upper surface and silvery or whitish below. It does not have any serious disease or pest problems, but gypsy moth caterpillars and Japanese beetles will sometimes feed on the foliage. Fall color is usually yellow. Improved varieties are available: Sterling®, Green Mountain®, Satin Shadow®.
