### **Turkish Filbert (*Corylus colurna*)**

Origin: Seed-grown, native to Eastern Europe and Western Asia

Mature Size: Medium to Large (35-45' tall)

Description: Turkish Filbert has a relatively slow rate of growth, and upright to pyramidal form. It is tolerant to a wide range of environmental conditions, and has no serious disease or pest problems, although gypsy moth caterpillars and fall webworms will sometimes feed on the leaves. Fall color is usually yellow. Larger trees will produce small thick-shelled nuts (hazels) if cross-pollinated.
