



## CITY OF ROCHESTER HILLS HAMLIN ROAD RECONSTRUCTION

Crooks Road to Livernois Road  
November, 2009



The City's contractor, Stante Excavating, is completing the final items of work to wrap up this year's construction on the reconstruction of Hamlin Road between Crooks Road and Livernois Road. While much has been completed, work still remains. Final grading of the area in back of the new curbed roadway west of Livernois is being completed. Items not completed in the reconstruction area include:

- Several business signs still require relocation.
- Pathway paving west of Livernois on both sides of the road still is required but may be delayed until Spring due to the wet ground conditions.
- Final topsoil and seeding will be complete next year after the path has been placed.
- Sprinkler repairs.
- New traffic signal installation at Crooks.
- Decorative concrete aprons placed on the inside of the crossovers.

Lastly, the roundabout construction has been delayed until the Spring of 2010 to ensure the intersection of Hamlin and Livernois will be fully operational for the entire winter. The roundabout work and paving east of Livernois on Hamlin should take about three months and will start in April 2010.

We appreciate the patience that the businesses and residents have had to endure during this project. While full access will be provided over the winter months, Hamlin at the Livernois intersection will be closed for a period of about three months starting next April. Access to and from Hamlin west of Livernois will be required to use Crooks Road only during this closure.

If you have not done so already, please do not forget to blow out your sprinkler systems. While many systems remain affected by the construction, water should still be removed from the lines as usual to prevent damage. The contractor will repair any damage to the existing systems caused by construction next Spring and will test the system to ensure that you are satisfied.
