



# Retiring of the Flag Ceremonies VFW Post 3908

We are very fortunate that our local VFW Post 3908, conducts semiannual "Retiring of the Flag" ceremonies. During the ceremony, they retire an average of 500 flags per service. Retired flags can be dropped off at the City of Rochester Hills Mayor's Office, or in the drop box located in front of the VFW Hall (the big red barn) located on the northeast corner of Auburn and Dequindre.

The **U.S. Flag Code** states, "The flag, when it is in such condition that it is no longer a fitting emblem for display, should be destroyed in a dignified way, preferably by burning."

Please be assured that your well used, tattered, ragged and/or faded flags will be properly disposed of in a respectful and patriotic flag retirement ceremony.
