

Public invited to July 7 meeting about Tienken Road Improvement Project

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in partnership with the City of Rochester Hills, will conduct an informational meeting Tuesday, July 7. At the meeting two alternatives for widening Tienken Road between Livernois and Sheldon Roads will be available for review and comment.

The meeting will be informal. Graphic displays will focus on possible road alignments and cross sections. Handouts comparing the alternatives will be available. Brief presentations will be made at 4:30 and 6:00 that will further describe the purpose and need for the project. RCOC representatives will be available thought the meeting to describe the alternatives and answer questions.

NEED AND PURPOSE FOR THE IMPROVEMENTS

- To provide adequate capacity to accommodate current and projected 2030 traffic volumes
 - Improve level of service at intersections
 - Improve level of service along segments
 - Reduce delay and frustration
- To improve safety by reducing crashes
 - Separate turning vehicles from through vehicles
 - Provide gaps in traffic stream to facilitate turns into and out of driveways
- To reconstruct structurally deficient sections of the road
- To improve sight distances in the corridor
 - Ability to see traffic in order to make right or left turns onto Tienken
 - Ability to see traffic in order to stop in time
- To improve air quality by reducing idling time
