



CITY OF ROCHESTER HILLS HAMLIN ROAD RECONSTRUCTION

Crooks Road to Livernois Road



Dear Road User:

As you are aware, the City has started the reconstruction of Hamlin Road between Crooks Road and Livernois Road.

The Project is staged for construction in multiple phases. The first stage has begun and involves the removal of trees that are within the grading limits of the project. In addition, the contractor has installed the temporary soil erosion and sedimentation control features as required for permit compliance with the Oakland County Water Resources Commission.

On or about April 20, 2009, Hamlin Road will be restricted to **ONE WAY** traffic, westbound, between Livernois and Crooks Road. This one-way traffic is anticipated to be in place until the end of June, 2009, weather permitting, at which time the north half of the boulevard should be completed and available for two way vehicular traffic.

The City realizes that there are going to be inefficiencies in the daily operations of many of the businesses utilizing the Hamlin Road corridor, but in conjunction with the Contractor, will attempt to minimize any anticipated inconveniences.
