

City of Rochester Hills 2009 Festival of the Hills Guidelines to Assist Political Parties Attending this Festival



The City of Rochester Hills invites you to attend our 2009 Festival of the Hills on Wednesday, July 1, 2009 at Borden Park. A full list of events and activities can be found on the City web site at www.rochesterhills.org

Musical entertainment, various family activities, and food concessions run from 6-10 p.m. and the massive fireworks show runs from approximately 10:00 –10:40 p.m.

Guidelines to follow:

- 1) The City will set aside an area along the south side of the tennis courts that will be available free of charge for politicians to set up booths. Please notify the City regarding any special needs for space such as cars, banners, lawn signs, helium tanks, etc. that you plan on bringing to ensure safety and compatibility with this event. **Lawn signs and banners are allowed only at this location.**
- 2) You are welcome to walk through the crowd distributing literature to park guests. You may not leave any unattended stacks of campaign material anywhere in the park and you may not place any literature under windshield wipers on vehicles parked inside Borden Park.
- 3) All helium tanks must be secured by being chained to a fence - you are welcome to chain helium tanks to the tennis court fence.
- 4) You are not allowed to pass out any food, drinks or “glow” type products due to exclusive concession agreements that are already in place.

Agreement and Waiver of Liability: In consideration for the opportunity to register and have booth/display space provided free of charge at this event, I agree to abide by the above guidelines and to the fullest extent permitted by law hereby release and agree to hold harmless the City of Rochester Hills, and elected and appointed officials, employees, and volunteers thereof, from any and all liability for any injury or damages whatsoever arising from or in connection with my participation in said activities. I have read the above information and agree to abide by the rules set forth in this document and all other park rules created by the City of Rochester Hills.

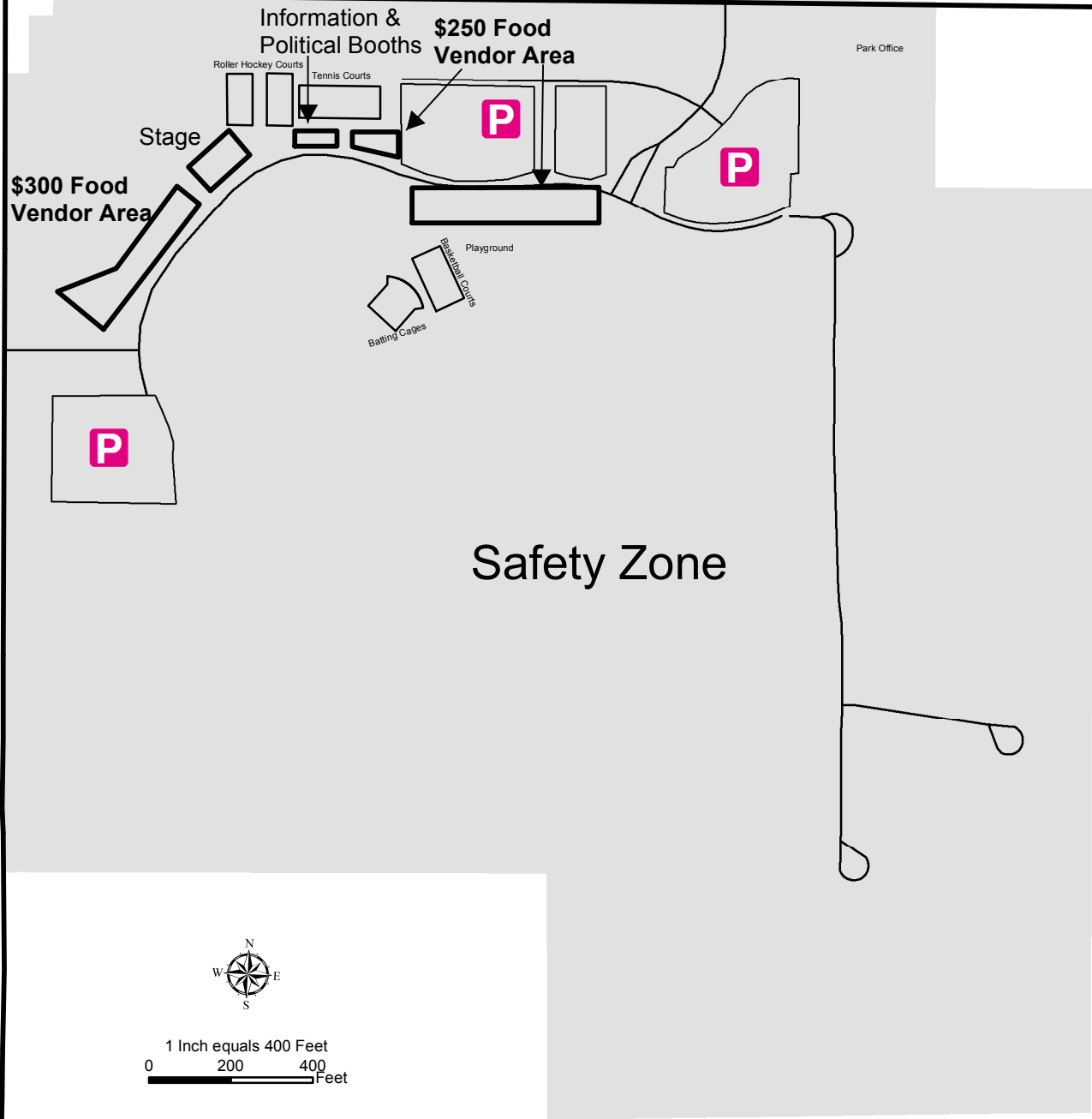
