FIELD RESERVATIONS

All fields may be reserved for a fee. Ball diamonds may be used on an unreserved first-come, first-served basis if not reserved by others and if not set up for a game that will take place later that day. Use of soccer fields requires a reservation.

All reservations are governed by the Sports Facilities Use Policy (Administrative Policy #405-1999). Reservation fees depend on residency/non-residency, age, field size, field use (game or practice), and required setups. Special rates are available for tournaments.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited within the Park.
2. Pets must be on a six-foot leash and under immediate control.
3. Speed limit within the Park is 15 mph.
4. No golfing, model rockets, or remote-controlled airplanes are permitted within the Park.
5. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
6. Visitors must abide by posted rules.
7. No snowmobiling or overnight parking is allowed within the Park.
8. Ground fires are prohibited.
9. Barbecue grills are allowed; however, ashes may not be discarded within the Park.
10. Destruction of property, natural surroundings, or wildlife within the Park is strictly forbidden.
11. Disorderly conduct or behavior that disturbs or annoys others within the Park is prohibited.
12. Firearms or weapons are strictly prohibited within the Park.
13. Kite flying is prohibited on soccer field #1, the ball diamonds, and on fields that are in use or prepped for a game.
