## Yates Park

- Yates Park offers a scenic outlook upon the Clinton River and Yates Dam. Fishing, walking and picnicking are among the favorite things to do.
- Park Hours are 8:00am until dusk everyday
- A vehicle permit is required. Daily permits can be purchased for \$5 when park attendants are on duty. Annual permits (good at all Rochester Hills Parks) are also available.
- Alcoholic beverages of any kind are strictly prohibited.
- Pets are allowed at the Park provided they are on 6ft. leashes and attended at all times.
- Yates Park is located on Avon Rd., just south of 23 Mile Rd.
