ORDINANCE NO. 543

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 110-404 OF CHAPTER 110, FEES, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ROCHESTER HILLS, OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN, TO MODIFY THE PERMIT FEE CHARGED FOR TEMPORARY SIGNS, REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES AND PRESCRIBE A PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS.

THE CITY OF ROCHESTER HILLS ORDAINS:

Section 1. Section 110-404 of the Code of Ordinances shall be amended as follows:

Sec. 110-404. Temporary signs.

Before the erection of a temporary sign, a permit fee ~~of \$25.00~~ shall be paid, as follows:

(a) First 30-day period: \$100.00

(b) For additional displays of same sign (covering up to 3 additional displays during same year): \$100.00

Section 2. Severability. This ordinance and each article, section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, part, provision, sentence, word and portion thereof are hereby declared to be severable, and if they or any of them are declared to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason

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by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is hereby provided that the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. Penalty. All violations of this ordinance shall be misdemeanors and upon conviction thereof shall be punishable by a sentence of not more than ninety (90) days of confinement to jail or by a fine of not more than \$500, or both, in the court's discretion.

Section 4. Repeal, Effective Date, Adoption.

(1) Repeal. All regulatory provisions contained in other City ordinances, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance, are hereby repealed.

(2) Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective on December 25, 2009, following its publication in the Rochester Post on December 24, 2009.

(3) Adoption. This ordinance was adopted by the City Council of the City of Rochester Hills at a meeting thereof held on December 14, 2009.
