ORDINANCE NO. 546

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ARTICLE VIII OF CHAPTER 54, FEES, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ROCHESTER HILLS, OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN, TO INCREASE PARK ENTRY AND SHELTER AND SPORTS FIELD RENTAL FEES, REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES AND PRESCRIBE A PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS.

THE CITY OF ROCHESTER HILLS ORDAINS:

Section 1. Article VIII of Chapter 54 of the Code of Ordinances shall be amended, as follows:

**ARTICLE VIII. PARKS AND RECREATION**

**Sec. 54-466. Spencer Park motor vehicle entry fees.**

The following schedule of motor vehicle entry fees shall apply only to Spencer Park. There shall be no charge for bicycles ridden into the park or for pedestrians. (Note: Status of residency to obtain the resident discount shall be determined by the vehicle registration.)

**Sec. 54-467. Bloomer Park and Yates Park motor vehicle entry fees.**

The following schedule of motor vehicle entry fees shall apply to Bloomer Park and Yates Park. There shall be no charge for bicycles ridden into the park or for pedestrians. Annual membershipspermits and senior citizen and handicap permitspasses shall be honored at Bloomer Park and Yates Park.

- (1) Bloomer/Yates annual permitpass .....~~\$25.00~~30.00
- (2) Bloomer/Yates daily permit .....5.00
- (3) Bus rate (11 passenger or greater capacity), twice the ~~established~~ annual permit fee.

**Sec. 54-468. Daily shelter rental.**

The fees for daily shelter rental, not including motor vehicle entry fee, shall be:

- (1) Stone Shelter .....~~\$200.00~~225.00
- (2) Mountain Ash Shelter .....~~75.00~~100.00
- (3) ~~All other shelters~~Pine-Grove Shelter .....~~150.00~~175.00
- (4) Hilltop Shelter .....175.00
- (5) Spencer Shelter .....200.00
- (6) Tent .....100.00

**Sec. 54-469. Commercial use of park grounds.**

The fees for commercial use of park grounds shall be as follows:

- (1) One-half day (up to four hours) .....\$300.00
- (2) Full day (four to eight hours) .....600.00

**Sec. 54-470. Museum and environmental education center.**

The following schedule of fees shall apply to the Rochester Hills Museum at Van Hoosen Farm, the Dairy Barn Facility, and the Rochester Hills Environmental Education Center:

  - c. Student .....3.00
  
- (2) Conferences, seminars, meetings and group use:
  - a. Non-profit groups:
    - During normal business hours:
      - One-hour minimum.....50.00
      - Additional hour or portion of an hour.....25.00
    - Other than normal business hours:
      - One-hour minimum.....100.00
      - Additional hour or portion of an hour.....50.00
  - b. For-profit groups:
    - During normal business hours:
      - One-hour minimum.....100.00
      - Additional hour or portion of an hour.....50.00
    - Other than normal business hours:
      - One-hour minimum.....150.00
      - Additional hour or portion of an hour.....100.00
  
- (3) Wedding fees:
  - a. Three-hour minimum .....700.00
  - b. Resident – Three hour minimum .....600.00
  - c. Additional hour or portion of an hour.....200.00
  - d. Reservation fee of museum grounds for wedding photography (per hour or portion of an hour) .....50.00
  - e. Wedding cancellation fee:
    - Nine months or more before ceremony .....50.00

- Less than nine months before ceremony.....200.00
- (4) Commercial use of museum buildings and grounds:
  - a. Buildings – Interior:
    - One-half (up to fours hours) .....750.00
    - Full day (four to eight hours).....1,500.00

    - One-half day (up to four hours) .....500.00
    - Full day (up to eight hours).....1,000.00
- (5) Museum membership fees:
  - a. Annual individual membership.....30.00
  - b. Annual individual plus membership .....40.00
  - c. Annual family membership.....50.00
  - d. Business partner membership .....250.00
  - e. Three-year individual membership.....75.00
  - f. Three-year individual plus membership .....105.00
  - g. Three-year family membership.....135.00

**Sec. 54-471. Sports field rental.**

Sports field rental fees are per game, per field, unless noted. Fees for sports fields include any motor vehicle entry fee. The field rental fees shall be as follows:

Section 2. Severability. This ordinance and each article, section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, part, provision, sentence, word and portion thereof are hereby declared to be severable, and if they or any of them are declared to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is hereby provided that the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

**CODIFIED ORDINANCE NO. 546**

Section 3. Penalty. All violations of this ordinance shall be misdemeanors and upon conviction thereof shall be punishable by a sentence of not more than ninety (90) days of confinement to jail or by a fine of not more than \$500, or both, in the court's discretion.

Section 4. Repeal, Effective Date, Adoption.

(1) Repeal. All regulatory provisions contained in other City ordinances, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance, are hereby repealed.

(2) Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective on December 25, 2009, following its publication in the *Rochester Post* on December 24, 2009.

(3) Adoption. This ordinance was adopted by the City Council of the City of Rochester Hills at a meeting thereof held on December 14, 2009.
