



ROCHESTER HILLS FIRE DEPARTMENT OFFICE BUILDING FIRE UNDER CONTROL

The Rochester Hills Fire Department, assisted by the City of Rochester Fire Department, responded to a structure fire at 2710 S. Rochester Road. Units arrived to find fire burning in a portion of the roof of the medical office building. Crews entered in an attempt to bring the fire under control, but were quickly driven from the building for safety reasons when it was discovered that the entire roof of the building was fully involved.
