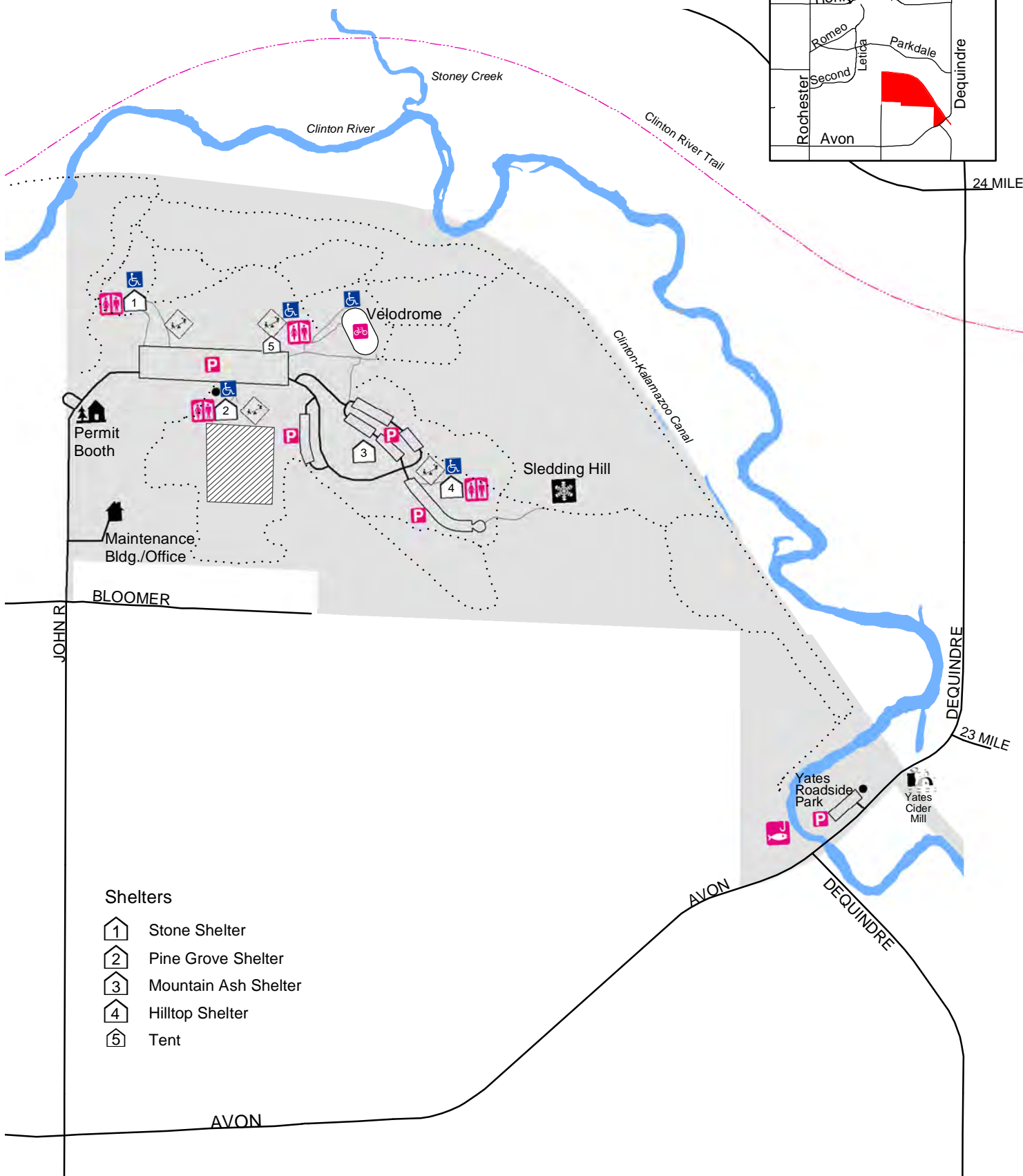
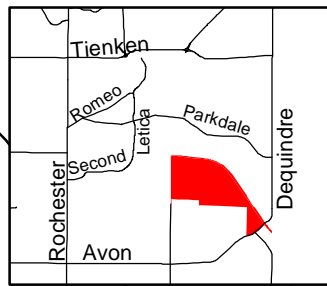
Stone Shelter	\$225/day

- Shelters reservable May through October
- Tent reservable Memorial Day through Labor Day weekends
- Shelter prices do not include vehicle entry fees.
- Shelters/tent include eight 6-foot picnic tables and a charcoal grill. Electrical service is available at Stone, Pine Grove, and Hilltop Shelters only.
- Restroom facilities in the shelters are open to the general public at all times.
- Decorations must be removed completely at the end of your event, with no damage to the property.
- Park management must approve all special arrangements not considered part of an average picnic prior to the reservation date.

Rules and Regulations (For a complete listing, please visit our website at www.rochesterhills.org/Parks.)

1. A City of Rochester Hills Park Permit is required for entry of all motor vehicles. Annual permits must be permanently attached to the windshield. Permits are nontransferable.
2. **Alcoholic beverages are prohibited within the park.**
3. Speed limit within the park is 15 mph.
4. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
5. Visitors must abide by posted rules.
6. The use of firearms or weapons is strictly prohibited.
7. All pets must be on a leash and under the owner's control.
8. NO trailers or snowmobiles.
9. NO ground fires.
10. NO destruction of property, natural surroundings, or wildlife.
11. NO disorderly conduct or behavior that disturbs others.
12. NO fireworks.
