MORTAR PERMIT FIRE RULES AND REGULATIONS

BURN PERMIT FOR PREPARATION OF MORTAR FIRE RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Fire must be attended at all times with adequate fire control measures on hand.
- No person shall start or maintain any fire within 50 feet of any structure or road right-of-way.
- Fuel for the fire shall consist only of wood or propane.
- Burning of materials such as plastics, rubber, hazardous materials, building materials, etc., is prohibited.
- Any violation of these requirements may void the permit, prevent the issuance of any further permits, and result in the issuance of a Municipal Civil Infraction.
- The permit holder may also be required to reimburse the Fire Department for all costs incurred as a result of responding to any violations of these guidelines.

ALL OTHER BURNING IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED

The Fire Department may refuse to allow burning if atmospheric conditions are not conducive to burning. Therefore, you must call the Fire Department for approval prior to burning. For approval call our automated information line at 248-656-4636 and follow the voice prompts.

I further understand that failure to abide by these Rules and Regulations will void the permit, prevent the issuance of any future permits and I will be fined accordingly.

When burning, this permit must be made available upon request.

YOU MUST CALL THE FIRE DEPARTMENT FOR APPROVAL PRIOR TO BURNING

The Fire Department may refuse to allow burning if atmospheric conditions are not conducive to burning. You must call the Fire Department for approval prior to burning. For approval, call our automated information line at 248-656-4636 and follow the voice prompts.
