

## 2011 CITY MILLAGES

City taxes are billed on the Winter Tax Statement.

<b>Operating Millages</b>	
<p><b>City General (Charter) -</b>                      Voters established Rochester Hills as a Charter City in May, 1984. The City can levy up to 5.0 mills of property tax for Governmental operations. City of Rochester Hills maximum millage rate is capped by the Headlee Amendment at 3.9132 mills. The City Council, for the 2011 budget year, has set the rate below the 2011 capped maximum millage allowed under the Headlee Amendment.</p>	3.7465
<p><b>Fire (Charter) -</b>                      The City can levy up to 2.5 mills for funding of the Fire Department. The maximum allowable millage rate is capped by the Headlee Amendment at 1.9564 mills. The City Council, for the 2011 budget year, has set the rate at the 2011 capped maximum millage allowed under the Headlee Amendment.</p>	1.9564
<p><b>Library -</b>                      Pursuant to Public Act 164 of 1877, as amended, City shall levy up to 1 mill for library purposes. The maximum allowable 2011 millage rate is capped by the Headlee Amendment at .7823 mills.</p>	0.7823
<p><b>Special Police #1 (Voted) -</b>                      20 year renewal of .8405 mills approved by the voters on 9/14/93 is authorized through 2013 tax year. The maximum allowable millage rate for 2011 is capped by the Headlee Amendment at .7823 mills.</p>	0.7823
<p><b>Special Police #2 (Voted) -</b>                      7 year renewal of .4260 mills approved by the voters on 9/11/07 is authorized through 2013 tax year.</p>	0.4260
<p><b>Older Persons' Commission (Voted) -</b>                      10 year renewal of .25 mills approved by the voters on 11/06/01 is authorized through 2011 tax year. The maximum allowable millage rate for 2011 is capped by the Headlee Amendment at .2403 mills.</p>	0.2403
<p><b>Older Persons' Commission Transportation (Voted) -</b>                      10 year renewal plus additional millage totalling .09 mills approved by the voters on 9/13/05 is authorized through 2014 tax year. The maximum allowable millage rate for 2011 is capped by the Headlee Amendment at .0891 mills.</p>	0.0891
<p><b>Rochester-Avon Recreation Authority (Voted) -</b>                      10 year renewal plus additional millage totalling .1950 mills approved by the voters on 8/8/06 is authorized through 2015 tax year.</p>	0.1950
<p><b>Green Space Preservation (Voted) -</b>                      10 year new millage of .30 mills approved by the voters on 9/13/05 is authorized through 2014 tax year. The maximum allowable millage rate for 2011 is capped by the Headlee Amendment at .2972 mills.</p>	0.2972
<p><b>Local Roads (Voted) -</b>                      10 year new millage of .3545 mills approved by the voters on 08/03/10 is authorized through 2019 tax year. The maximum allowable millage rate for 2011 is capped by the Headlee Amendment at .3545 mills.</p>	0.3545
<p><b>Pathway (Voted) -</b>                      20 year renewal of .1858 mills approved by the voters on 11/07/06 is authorized through 2025 tax year. The maximum allowable millage rate for 2011 is capped by the Headlee Amendment at .1858 mills.</p>	0.1858
<b>Debt Millages</b>	
<p><b>Chapter 20 Drain Bond -</b>                      Unlimited millage authorized by State law - Chapter 20 Drain Code.</p>	0.4057
<p><b>Older Persons Refunding Debt 2010 (Voted) -</b>                      Unlimited millage approved in 2000 by voters for repayment of bond debt to build new older persons center. Authorized through 2020 tax year. (Original amount \$9,770,000; Bond refunding in 2010.)</p>	0.2449
